RULES

Exhibitors must check-in on Saturday, September 26, 2009 between 8:30 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. to receive site assignments, and be fully set-up by 10:00 a.m. ***Exhibit must be displayed until 5:00 p.m. - NO EXCEPTIONS.***

MCAC will provide 10' x 10' sites, but exhibitors must provide their own **tables, chairs, display panels, trash receptacles , and/or canopies.** *Electricity will not be available.*

The event will take place **rain or shine.** If exhibitors choose not to participate due to weather conditions, the *entry fee will not be refunded.*

Exhibitors must accept cash or checks, or have their own credit systems. Collection and reporting Maryland State Tax of 6% is the sole responsibility of each exhibitor.

All merchandise must be original, handmade, and created by exhibitor.

The MCAC Art In The Park Committee reserves the right to require any exhibitor to remove parts or all of his/her display that are not in keeping with the purpose and safety of the event. ***Entry fee will not be refunded.***

Exhibitors are responsible for their assigned spaces at all times. MCAC will not be responsible for missing items.

MCAC will not be responsible or liable for any loss or damage. Insurance is the responsibility of the exhibitor.

In addition to MCAC requirements, the exhibitor and any guests must abide by the rules and regulations for Smallwood State Park. Call (301) 743-7613 or see www.dnr.state.md.us

Obey all posted signs and notices. Park only in designated areas.

Exhibitor site must be packed up and cleaned (completely trash free) by 6:15 p.m.
