This workshop is geared toward amateur photographers interested in learning techniques and secrets for producing quality photos of hummingbirds and enjoying it. It will include: setting up a hummingbird habitat, using creative staging equipment, and learning tricks to make the photography process easier. Bring your cameras and camera manuals. Tripods are useful but not required.

Topics covered will include:

- Creating an environment that will draw hummingbirds to your yard, including flower types particularly enjoyed by the birds.
- Choosing and maintaining feeders for the hummers.
- Making tools to make your photo process easier.
- Reviewing camera settings and basic technical information.
- Selecting photo equipment and using it to the best advantage.
- Setting up your “outdoor studio” and enticing hummers to pose for you.
- Practicing taking photos. (Note: no live hummers will be used in this presentation!)
- Doing magic things with your finished photos.
